I recently had the opportunity to visit Pam Lake's kennel facility that is the site of her breeding operation for her German Shepherds and Cairn Terriers.



Overall, I was impressed that each dog was in healthy condition with a very healthy skin and hair coat. No mites or any other parasites were identified.
